

A MICROCHIP IS THE WAY HOME.

A microchip is a tiny device, about the size of a grain of rice, implanted just under your dog's skin. It contains a unique ID number that can be scanned by shelters, vets, and rescues to help reunite you with your dog.

BUT here's the key:

A microchip only works if it's registered with your current contact information.

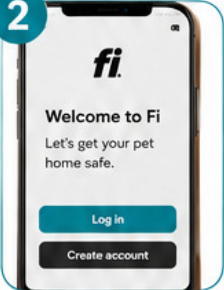

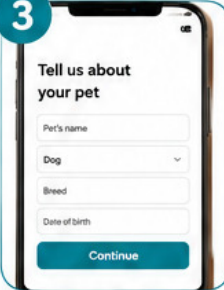


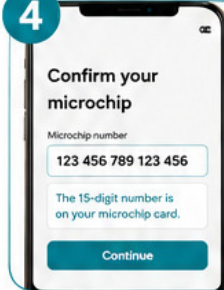
HOW TO REGISTER YOUR FI MICROCHIP

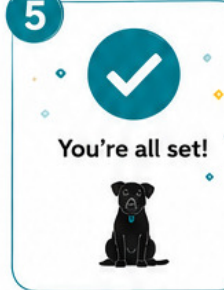
Using Your QR Code Card

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SCAN THE QR CODE
Use your phone's camera to scan the QR code on the yellow Fi card we provided.
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CREATE OR LOG IN
You'll be taken to the Fi Nano registration page. Create a new account or log in to your existing account.
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ENTER YOUR DOG'S INFO
Enter your dog's name, breed, date of birth, and any other requested details.
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CONFIRM CHIP NUMBER
The 15-digit microchip number should auto-populate. If not, enter it manually from your card.
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COMPLETE REGISTRATION
Add your contact information and finish the registration. You're all set!

THE COMEBACK PACK IS YOUR BACKUP CONTACT—AND IT STAYS THAT WAY!

When you register your Fi microchip, The Comeback Pack is listed as the backup contact. This means if your contact information ever changes or something happens, we can still be reached to help get your dog home.

WE REQUIRE THAT THE COMEBACK PACK REMAINS THE BACKUP CONTACT.

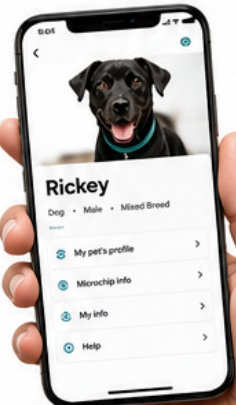
This extra layer of support helps ensure your dog is always protected—no matter what.

IMPORTANT REMINDERS

- ♥ Keep your phone number and email up to date in your Fi account.
- ♥ If you move or change numbers, log in and update your info.
- ♥ A microchip is not a GPS tracker—it must be scanned to work.
- ♥ Always keep a current ID tag on your dog's collar as the first line of defense!
